We would like to invite you to participate in the 7th International Congress of Social Inclusion organized by the Institute of Education, the University of Natural Sciences and Humanities (UPH) in Siedlce.

The congress will take place from **14 to 15 May 2020 in the building of the Faculty of Humanities UPH at 39 Żytnia Street, Siedlce, postal code 08-110.**

Scientific centres, institutions dealing with the exclusion and inclusion of the elderly as well as all those involved in actions against social exclusion are invited to take part in the Congress.

**Congress topics**

Scientific projects within the framework of the International Congress of Social Inclusion have been organized by our University since 2014. These are scientific meetings with an aim of broadening the knowledge of social inclusion in the context of social and cultural changes.

Such prestigious and interdisciplinary events integrate domestic and foreign representatives of various scientific fields, in particular in the areas of humanities and social, economic and legal sciences.

The aim of the 7th International Congress of Social Inclusion is to present the achievements of Polish and foreign scientists and practitioners in the most important issues concerning comprehensive activities dealing with social inclusion of the elderly. The participants of the Congress will also attempt to define a coherent vision of inclusive actions against the exclusion of elderly people in social policy and in education in Poland and in the world.

The scientific reflections of this year's Congress will include the following topics:

1. Social exclusion of the elderly – aetiology, phenomenology and ways of prevention.
2. Modern problems of elderly care – beliefs, prejudices and stereotypes in the perception of senior citizens.
3. Ageism in the modern world, Universities of the Third Age, projects and other social activities towards the elderly.
4. Safety of the elderly.

We hope that the scientific discourse, to which you are cordially invited, will serve innovative solutions in the area of social inclusion of the elderly not only in Poland, but also in the European Union.

**The aftermath of our deliberations will be the release of peer-reviewed scientific monographs (with 20 publication points for a chapter in a monograph).**

You are also invited to publish an article in our journal "The Disabled Student. Sketches and theses".

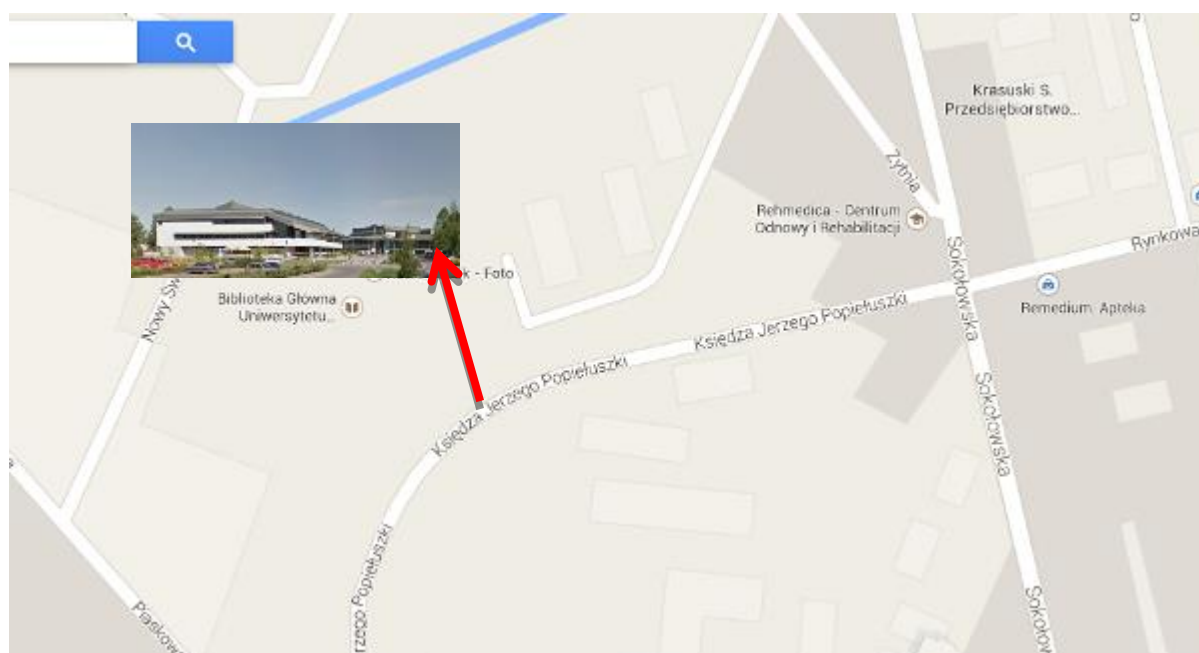
